Formed in early spring 2006, the Raleigh Sidewinders is eastern North Carolina's new wheelchair (i.e. Quad Rugby) team. The new team is a result of the interest generated from the academy award nominated documentary **MURDERBALL** and the success of a local quad rugby clinic sponsored by the North Carolina Spinal Cord Injury Association (NCSCIA). The Raleigh Sidewinders are official members of the US Quad Rugby Association, (USQRA), www.quadrugby.com. The Raleigh Sidewinders is one of two teams in North Carolina and is included in the Atlantic South division of the USQRA.

Highlights of the last three seasons include hosting three annual local tournaments, the Raleigh Rumble 2007, 2008 and 2009. We were also the proud hosts of the USQRA 2008 Atlantic Sectional tournament! We are looking forward to an active 2009-2010 Season, with expected participation in six scheduled tournaments.

The team is comprised of individuals with disabilities that preclude their play in competitive, able-bodied sports. Players must have mobility impairments in their arms and legs to be considered eligible for participation. Most of the players have sustained cervical spinal cord injuries and have some type of quadriplegia as a

result. The players are active members in their community, striving for a level of skill and competition offered by quad rugby.

The Raleigh Sidewinders quad rugby team is a program sponsored by NCSCIA, a non-profit organization whose mission is to provide resources to support the highest level of independence, health and personal fulfillment for those with spinal cord injuries and disease.
